LEE Valley Lions got the cold shoulder from high-flying Invicta Dynamos as they crashed to a one-sided defeat at the Lee Valley Ice Centre on Sunday.

The weekend got worse for Lee Valley as they crashed to defeat away to Oxford on Sunday – going 10-0 down at the end of the second period.

New signing Kwabina Öppong-Addai took advantage of a powerplay and scored unassisted. It was the Lions' only goal of the night – but at least it meant they won the period!
