
## TURNER GIVES SPITFIRES DERBY PRIZE

MATT Turner's 52nd-minute goal completed a fine fightback and derby success for Spitfires on Saturday.

Turner netted his 12th goal of the season, on a powerplay, as the home side wiped out a two-goal deficit in the final period to take the points from their London rivals.

Lions started well, forcing Ben Clements into early action, and were given a spell of 5-on-3 when Ian Robinson, Turner and Luke Bramble were all binned in quick succession.

The visitors made the powerplay count as Rob Courtman found the net but Spitfires got themselves back on terms in the 14th minute courtesy of Sam Park's effort.

The home side then took the lead two minutes later when Ricky Mills was credited with a goal, after the puck appeared to go in off a Lee Valley player during a scramble in front of George Allev's net.

An interference call against Park gave Lions the chance to level on a second-period powerplay through defenceman James

seconds later through Turner to give themselves hope and Matt Brown made it 4-4 with ten minutes remaining.
